PLEASE READ THESE IMPORTANT GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Deposits and Payments

An initial deposit of \$600 per person is required to hold your desired stateroom category and ensure quoted cruise rate. A second payment of \$750 per person (total \$11350) is due by February 28, 2011. Final payment is due no later than May 15, 2011. Checks should be made payable to "Value Travel, Inc." Payments may also be made by credit card. Consult your invoices or statements for specific due dates.

Cancellations and Refunds

If a cancellation occurs, the following charges may be assessed:

Trip Cancellation Protection Plan: Optional Trip Cancellation Protection is available and will be included on your invoice. You may opt out of this coverage by **completing a Trip Cancellation Waiver declining coverage.** Your payment for Travel Cancellation Protection **must be paid by check & be included with your initial deposit to waive pre-existing conditions.** By enrolling for cancellation coverage within 14 days of making your initial deposit, preexisting conditions are waived. Complete plan information is available by request from your agent. "Cancel For Any Reason" coverage is also available. Request rates.

Identification

Proper travel identification is your responsibility, and is required at embarkation and throughout your trip. Any guest traveling without proper identification may be denied boarding, and no refunds will be issued. **Each United States citizen regardless of age, must present identification and proof of citizenship in the form of a valid United States passport. We urge all United States citizens to acquire a passport.** U.S. Alien residents need a valid Alien Resident Card. Canadian citizens must present a valid passport. Other non-U.S. citizens should check with their respective embassies for required documentation.

Travel Documents

Guest names on travel documents (passport, Alien Resident Card, etc.) must be identical to those on trip documents.

Guests are responsible for reviewing their documents for errors. If the name in the address box on the face of this statement does not appear exactly as the name on your passport, call this office at once. Substantial fees are charged by the airline/tour/cruise operators to make corrections once tickets are issued. This applies to both first and last names. Name change or name correction fees are the responsibility of the customer.

Baggage and Transportation Security Administration Requirements

The number of bags and weight limitations required by airlines is changing. Consult directly with your air carrier for these limitations. Limitations on items that may be carried in your hand luggage is changing depending on current TSA requirements. Travelers are encouraged to check before arriving at the airport for current limitations. Airlines may also charge extra fees not included on your Value Travel invoice.

Embarkation

Guest should review their travel documents for boarding, air departure, and sailing times. Guests are responsible for being at departure gates, or on-board ship a minimum of two hours prior to departure.

Tipping

Most Cruise Lines will automatically charge your on-board account to cover gratuities for your cabin steward and your dining room team. This charge is typically \$10 per day per person. Additional tipping is a personal matter and completely up to you. The following gratuities are suggested if you feel the service warrants additional tipping: Alternative Dining Service Staff-\$0.75 per guest, per day, your Maitre d' at your discretion, based on the service you received. Other service personnel, such as bar and room service staff may be tipped as service is rendered. For your convenience on board the ship, a 15% gratuity is automatically included on all beverage tabs. You may prepay gratuities along with your stateroom fare and optional trip cancellation protection.

Rates & Fares

Additional government taxes and fees for individual purchases, taxes on additional transportation, shore excursions, medical services, items of a personal nature such as bar beverages, gifts, shop purchases, beauty salon/barber shop and massage services, gambling and service/porterage gratuities are not included in the cruise rate.

Guest Cruise Card

For your convenience, charges for most of your onboard purchases are made to your Cruise Card account. A required application will be included with your ticket documents or on-line registration. Most major credit cards and cash for deposit on your account are accepted. For cash deposits, a minimum of \$200 per person is usually required. This may be higher on trips of longer duration.

Liquor Policy

Most cruise lines prohibits guests from bringing beverages of any kind for consumption on board the ship. You may purchase mixed drinks and other beverages from any of the ship's bars and lounges. Cruise lines reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcoholic beverages to anyone. Alcoholic beverages purchased in the ship's gift shops or in foreign ports are generally retained by the cruise line until the end of the voyage.
